Rick Eggebrecht with Novita, contacted the Zoning office stating, "They are anticipating the plant to start production on October 31st, of 2016, with full production being in the middle of November, 2016. The hard surfaced roads and parking lot at the plant site may not be completed until the spring of 2017, due to the shorten construction season and upcoming fall/winter weather. He also mentioned that the construction of the berm has been completed and test wells have been installed by BMU."
