BRIDGE REINSPECTION  
PROGRAM RESOLUTION  
FOR USE WITH SDDAT RETAINER CONTRACTS

**WHEREAS**, Title 23, Section 151, *United States Code* and Title 23, Part 650, Subpart C, *Code of Federal Regulations*, requires initial inspection of all bridges and reinspection at intervals not to exceed two years with the exception of reinforced concrete box culverts that meet specific criteria. These culverts are reinspected at intervals not to exceed four years.

**THEREFORE**, Moody County is desirous of participating in the Bridge Inspection Program using Bridge Replacement funds.

The County request SDDOT to hire Clark Engineering Corp. (Consulting Engineers) for the inspection work. SDDOT will secure federal approvals, make payments to the Consulting Engineer for inspection services rendered, and bill the County 20% of the cost. The County will be responsible for the required 20% matching funds.
