


IMPACT PROGRAMS

211 is a three-digit telephone number that can provide quick and easy access to information about health and human services. Community members in the Brookings area can access this program by calling 211 or texting your zip code to 898211. You can also search the database at helplinecenter.org.

In 2015, Brookings County residents, ages 11 to 95, made 562 calls and 754 website searches specifically for Brookings area resources.



DENTAL VAN

Dakota Smiles Dental Program was in Brookings the last week in January and second week in April. Combined, they saw 86 children between the ages of 0-21 and performed over \$57,000 in dental care. Brookings Area United Way pays \$2500 to bring the Dental Van in and this year they are coming for an additional week. They will be in Brookings during the second week in August. FAMILYWISE

How the FamilyWise Prescription Savings Card Works

- 1. Get your free card – available three different ways:**
 - Print your card from familywise.org
 - Download the FamilyWise app on your smartphone
 - Call Brookings United way at 605-692-4979 to have a card mailed to you.
- 2. Show your pharmacist the FamilyWise card every time you fill a prescription.**
- 3. Get the lowest price possible – from FamilyWise, from the pharmacy, or from your insurance.**

From January to April 2016, community members in Brookings County have saved over \$920 with the FamilyWise prescription card.



DOLLY PARTON IMAGINATION LIBRARY

1,805 preschool children in Brookings County currently received the gift of free books. The Brookings Area United Way funds the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library program to monthly mail one age appropriate, brand new book per month to children birth to five. This program is part of the Early Childhood initiative to get children ready for school, which lead to higher graduation rates.
