

BROOKINGS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2017-04

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PLACEMENT OF 4-WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF 32ND STREET SOUTH AND 22ND AVENUE SOUTH

BE IT ORDAINED BY BROOKINGS COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to SDCL 32-29-2, Brookings County has the authority to erect stop or yield signs at the intersections of roadways under Brookings County jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, Representatives from the City of Brookings and from Brookings County have agreed that placement of 4-way stop signs at the intersection of 32nd Street South and 22nd Avenue South would benefit the general welfare and safety of the citizens of Brookings County.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY BROOKINGS COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, that 4-way stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of 32nd Street South and 22nd Avenue South.
