

RESOLUTION NO. 91-10

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A HEARING TO DETERMINE
THE NEED FOR A HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the South Dakota County and Municipal Housing and Redevelopment Law, SDCL Chapter 11-7, creates a "Housing and Redevelopment Commission" in each County, and provides that such a Commission shall not transact any business or exercise any powers until the governing body of the County by resolution shall declare that there is need for a Commission to function in such County,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Brookings, South Dakota;

That on the 2nd day of April, 1991, at 9:30 o'clock a.m., at the Commission Chambers in the Brookings County Courthouse, Brookings, South Dakota, being the time and place of a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Brookings County, South Dakota, this body shall determine:

(a) Whether slum or blighted areas exist in Brookings County, South Dakota, or;

(b) Whether unsanitary or unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist, or;

(c) Whether there is a shortage of decent, safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations in Brookings County, South Dakota, available to persons of low income at rentals or prices they can afford,

That at such meeting a public hearing will be held on these matters,

That all interested persons be and hereby are invited


to attend said hearing and present evidence to this body,

That the Auditor be and he hereby is directed to cause this resolution to be published for one publication in each of the following: Brookings Register, Elkton Record and Volga Tribune, the legal newspapers published in Brookings County, South Dakota,


The motion to adopt the resolution was made by Commissioner Sherry DeBoer and seconded by Commissioner Lloyd Sterud and upon roll call the following voted YEAS 4, NAYS 0, ABSTAIN 1.

Thereupon the Chairman declared said resolution duly adopted and passed.
