

RESOLUTION NO. 91-11

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR A HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION IN BROOKINGS COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA.

Pursuant to Resolution No. 91-10 adopted by this body on the 19th day of March, 1991, a hearing has been held by the Brookings County Commission at Brookings, South Dakota, to determine the need for a Housing and Redevelopment Commission to function in such Brookings County.

Whereas, facts have been submitted to this body showing that there is need for a Housing and Redevelopment Commission to function in Brookings County, South Dakota.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF BROOKINGS, SOUTH DAKOTA

That the County Commission of Brookings County, South Dakota pursuant to the "County and Municipal Housing and Redevelopment Law" of the State of South Dakota, hereby finds, determines and declares:

1. There exists in Brookings County, South Dakota Slum or blighted areas;:
2. Unsanitary or unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in Brookings County, South Dakota;
3. There is a shortage of decent, safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations available to persons of low income and their families at rentals they can afford;
4. It is hereby declared that there is a need for a Housing and Redevelopment Commission to function in Brookings County, South Dakota, and said need continues to exist.
