

DRAINAGE BOARD

SDCL 46A-10A-2. County drainage commission- Appointment filling vacancies- majority required to act- Ex officio member. The board of county commissioners of each county may appoint a commission of three or more member, the total membership of which shall always be an uneven number and at least one member of which shall be a member of the board, to be known as the county drainage commission. If a commission member resigns his position, is unable to fulfill the duties of his position or is removed for cause under the provisions of SDCL 46A-10A-3, the board shall appoint a new member to the commission within thirty days. A commission may not conduct official business unless all memberships of the commission are filled and unless a majority of the members are present at a meeting of the commission. Administrative officials of the county may be present as ex officio members of the commission, but shall have no vote in commission matters. SDCL 46A-10A-3. Term and removal of member. The term of office for members of a county drainage commission shall be established by the board of county commissioners. Any appointed member of a county drainage commission may be removed for cause, after a hearing prior to the expiration of his term, by a majority vote of the elected member of the board of county commissioners.

Current County Appointment:

At present, the Brookings County Board of County Commissioners acts as the Drainage Commission.
