A RESOLUTION TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE RENOVATION AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO THE CURRENT BROOKINGS COUNTY DETENTION CENTER

WHEREAS, the Brookings County Commission has been discussing the need for an expansion of the Brookings County Detention Center since 1999; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need for additional county jail bed space based on ongoing reports from the Brookings County Sheriff's Department; and


WHEREAS, analysis of the pre-design phase of the proposed project has further demonstrated the necessity of the project and the financial feasibility to move forward with the project; and

WHEREAS, the Brookings County Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is necessary that the County remodel and expand the current Brookings County Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, there is a general financial plan in place to fund the construction with the issuance of bonds and the expected creation of a capital projects fund for the specific purpose of constructing and remodeling the current jail facility, as well as an expansion to the current facility, whereby the capital projects fund will receive a transfer of funds from the General Fund and the Building Fund to initiate the project.


