


BROOKINGS COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 20-63


WHEREAS, South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) 7-11-4.2 requires the County Finance Officer to present a list of all uncollectable non-sufficient fund checks to the Board of County Commissioners. The board has examined such returns and, is satisfied with reports from the Finance Officer that the non-sufficient funds cannot be collected.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Brookings County Commissioners, at a regular meeting November 5th, 2020 to direct the County Finance Officer to remove these items as an asset of Brookings County.

7-11-4.2. Bad check--Collection procedure--Removal as asset.

If a county receives an insufficient fund or no account check, the county shall institute a collection procedure. If after one hundred eighty days the county has not received payment for the insufficient fund or no account check, the county treasurer may, with the majority approval of the board of county commissioners, remove the insufficient fund or no account check as an asset of the county.

RE: Removal of NSF checks

I am bringing you 5 NSF checks that have been on the books ranging from 2015 through June of 2019. The first 4 had been sent to the States Attorney's office for collection and we have never received any money. The last check in the amount of \$213.06 was sent to the Sheriff's office to collect the money or remove the license plates and was informed he no longer lived in the county. We contacted the State and was informed that he moved out of State so we could not collect this amount. I've have worked with Dan Nelson and he agrees we should take them off the books.
