

ORDINANCE NO. 96-3

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 35  
MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT UPON  
A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD 16

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SDCL 32-24-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, because of the high volume of traffic; and the nature and condition of the road involved, it appears necessary to reduce the speed limit on a portion of Brookings County Road 16 to provide for the safety and welfare of all residents and travelers on such road.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that a speed limit of 35 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of Brookings County Road 16 commencing at the intersection between County Road 16 and County Road 77 and continuing approximately one and one half (1 1/2) miles west to the intersection with the township road.
