

# ORDINANCE 96-12

## *Establishing a 25 mph Speed Limit Upon a Portion of Medary Township Roads*

WHEREAS, pursuant to SDCL 32-35-9.1, the County has the authority to establish speed zones on any part of the highways within its jurisdiction on the request of and after any other local authority having charge of the maintenance thereof has declared its intention to post a speed zone; and


WHEREAS, because of the nature and condition of roads in Medary Township, it is in the interest of the safety and welfare of all residents and travelers to maintain the speed limit of 25 miles per hour on a portion of such roads; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Medary Township has requested that the Brookings County Board of Commissioners establish a speed zone of 25 miles per hour along the portion of such township road beginning seven tenths (7/10th) of a mile east of the intersection of 219th Street and 467th Avenue continuing to the end of this dead-end road, a distance of approximately eight tenths (8/10th) of a mile.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that a speed limit of 25 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established along the portion of such township road beginning seven tenths (7/10th) of a mile east of the intersection of 219th Street and 467th Avenue continuing to the end of this dead-end road, a distance of approximately eight tenths (8/10th) of a mile, in the Medary Township highway system.


**A Resolution to Establish a Speed Limit  
on A Medary Township Road**

Whereas, pursuant to SDCL 32-25-91.1, the Brookings County Board of Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones on streets and highways at the request of the Township Board of Supervisors, and


Whereas, because of the amount of traffic and the number of entrances to residential homes and because the condition of the road permits traffic to move at a speed faster than what is safe, a reduced speed is warranted on the Medary Township road signed as Lake Shore Drive, a part of 219th St. located in an easterly direction from Brookings Co. Road 17, also designated as 467th Ave.,

Therefore, the Medary Township Board of Supervisors requests that the Brookings County Board of Commissioners establish a speed zone of 25 miles per hour along that portion of such township road, beginning seven tenths (7/10th) of a mile east of the intersection of 219th St. and 467th Ave., continuing to the end of this dead-end road, a distance of approximately eight tenths (8/10th) of a mile.
