

ORDINANCE NO. 97-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 40  
MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT UPON  
A TOWNSHIP ROAD

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SDCL 32-24-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, because of the high volume of traffic; the close proximity to the city limits of Volga, the nature and condition of the road involved, it appears necessary to reduce the speed limit on Volga Township road to provide for the safety and welfare of all residence and travelers on such a road.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of Volga Township road commencing at Sixth Street and Lincoln Lane on the east edge of Volga, continuing east through Section 23 to Caspian Avenue.
