

Ordinance #2008-02

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS UPON
CERTAIN MEDARY TOWNSHIP ROADS.**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SDCL 32-24-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, because of the high volume of traffic; the close proximity to the city limits of Brookings, the nature and condition of the road involved, it appears necessary to reduce the speed limit on Medary Township roads to provide for the safety and welfare of all residence and travelers on such road.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the following speed limits be and the same are hereby established on the following portions of Medary Township roads:

- 35 Miles Per Hour on Medary Avenue South, from city limits south to 471st Avenue.
- 35 Miles Per Hour on Western Avenue South, from city limits south to 44th Street South.
- 35 Miles Per Hour on 32nd Street South, from Main Avenue South to W.16th Avenue.
- 35 Miles Per Hour on 218th Avenue (aka: Northshore Drive), west of 469th Avenue
- 35 Miles Per Hour on Danceland Road, North of 220th Street.
- 25 Miles Per Hour on 219th Street (aka: Westlake Drive), East of 467th Avenue beginning at the residences.
- 25 Miles Per Hour on 219th Street (aka: Country Club Road), West of 469th Avenue.
