

ORDINANCE # 2009-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 45 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT UPON A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD 12

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SDCL 32-24-9.1, Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, The Brookings County Commission has received a request from the Brookings County Highway Superintendent to post speed limit below the default 55 mph due to the number of complaints received about vehicles traveling at high speeds on the listed road;

WHEREAS, Because of the high volume of traffic and the nature and condition of the road involved, it appears necessary to reduce the speed limit on a portion of Brookings County Road 12 to provide for the safety and welfare of all residents and travelers on such road.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that a speed limit of 45 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of Brookings County Road 12 as described below:
~~Beginning at the~~ North West (NW) Corner of Section Fourteen (14) in Township One Hundred Nine (109) North, Range Fifty (50) West of the 5th PM. Brookings County South Dakota, and progressing in a Easterly direction for a distance of approximately 1.0 mile on County Road 12 to both intersections with County Road 77.

Beginning at a point 1000 feet east of the
