

BROOKINGS COUNTY ORDINANCE #2024-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 45 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT
UPON A PORTION OF BROOKINGS COUNTY ROAD 16A,
ALSO KNOWN AS 214TH STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY BROOKINGS COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to SDCL 32-25-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, South Dakota Department of Transportation Secretary Joel Jundt signed Executive Order No. 2024-1, Brookings County, on May 8, 2024, formally approving Brookings County taking over a portion of 214th Street, also known as Brookings County Road 16A.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that a speed limit of 45 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of Brookings County Road 16A (214th Street) commencing at the southwest corner of T110N, R49W, section 32, at the intersection of 214th Street and 34th Avenue, then east approximately 2.500 miles to the west city limits of the City of Aurora, in Aurora and Trenton Townships, Brookings County, South Dakota.
