

BROOKINGS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2025-07

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE 2024-01

WHEREAS, BROOKINGS COUNTY, previously adopted Ordinance 2024-01 in accordance with SDCL Chapter 11-2;

WHEREAS, the Brookings County, South Dakota, Board of County Commissioners deems it necessary, for the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and the general welfare of the County, to amend Ordinance 2024-01 by amending Article IV District Requirements, Chapter 4.07 Transmission Pipeline Risk Reduction Overlay District; Section 4.07.05.02 Planning Zone: Liquid Pipelines

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROOKINGS COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA: that Article IV District Requirements, Chapter 4.07 Transmission Pipeline Risk Reduction Overlay District; Section 4.07.05.02 Planning Zone: Liquid Pipelines: is hereby amended by removing strike out and adding in underline font:

~~3. A planning distance for liquid pipelines may be defined based on a pipeline and location-specific analysis considering the following three elements:~~

- ~~• How much liquid might be spilled?~~
- ~~• Where would the spilled liquid go?~~
- ~~• What locations would be impacted?~~

3. As a starting point for HLP placement in Brookings County the following setbacks, which are in place for Confined Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) are in place for placement of HLP pipelines.

<u>Established Residences</u>	<u>2,640 feet</u>
<u>Adjoining Property Lines</u>	<u>330 feet</u>
<u>Churches, Businesses and Commercially Zoned Areas</u>	<u>2,640 feet</u>
<u>Incorporated Municipality Limits</u>	<u>5,280 feet</u>
<u>Established Private Water Well</u>	<u>250 feet</u>
<u>Existing Public Water Well</u>	<u>1,000 feet</u>
<u>Lakes and Streams classified as Fisheries as identified by the State</u>	<u>150 feet</u>


