South Dakota 4-H requires each 4-H'er to attend a minimum of 4 instructional practices/meetings (match and fun shoots do not count towards the 4 practices) and pass the safety test before participating at the State Level. Failure to attend required practices may affect registration the following year. Parents are also needed to attend at least 4 times to help assist with the program.

The purpose of Match 3 is to encourage the beginner shooters. Match 3 will be for any shooters who did not qualify for the State Shoot in a previous match, and not to add a new discipline.

Safety First: No electronic devices or headphones are allowed to be used in the shooting area.
